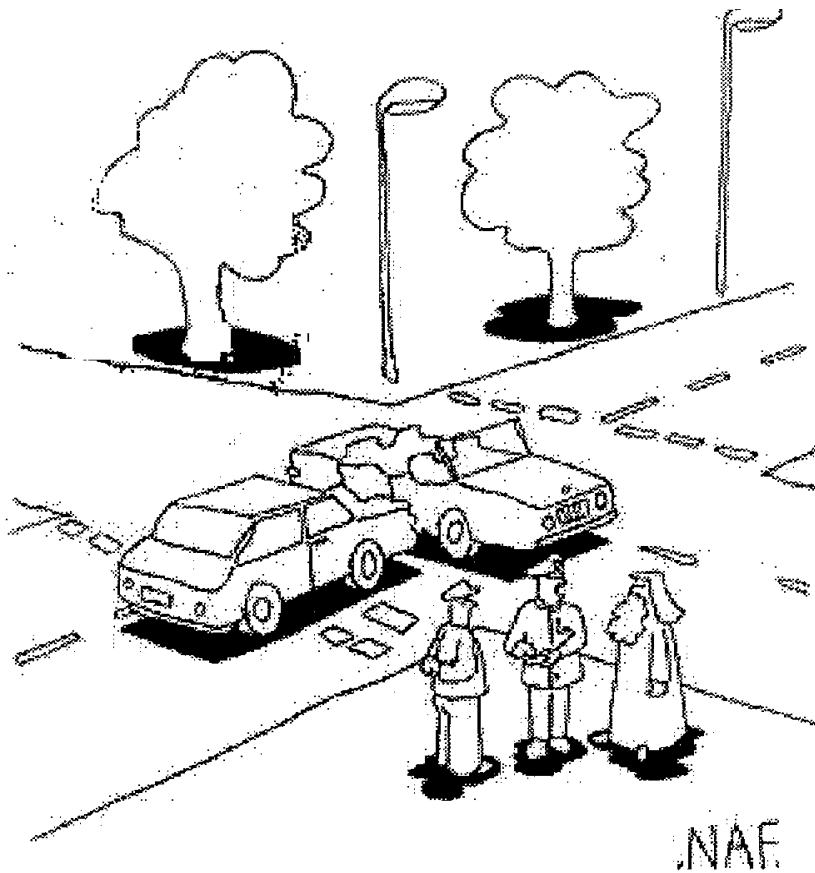


What to do in case of a motor vehicle accident



Keep this pamphlet in your car

PROCEDURES TO FOLLOW IN CASE OF A MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT

1. Stop immediately and switch off the vehicle engine.
2. Place emergency triangles in appropriate position.
3. Call emergency service/police if deemed necessary.
4. No vehicle may be moved, if any person is injured or fatally injured.
5. Do not use any alcohol or drugs for shock on the scene of the accident unless administered by a doctor.
6. Provide the following information to any person who might need it:
Name, address and particulars of owner of the vehicle.
Registration information of vehicle and insurance company name
7. Stay calm and avoid arguments. Under no circumstances commit to guilt or wrong doing, even if you feel you are guilty. Do not sign any documentation!!
8. Report the accident within 24 hours to your local police station, follow up on case number.

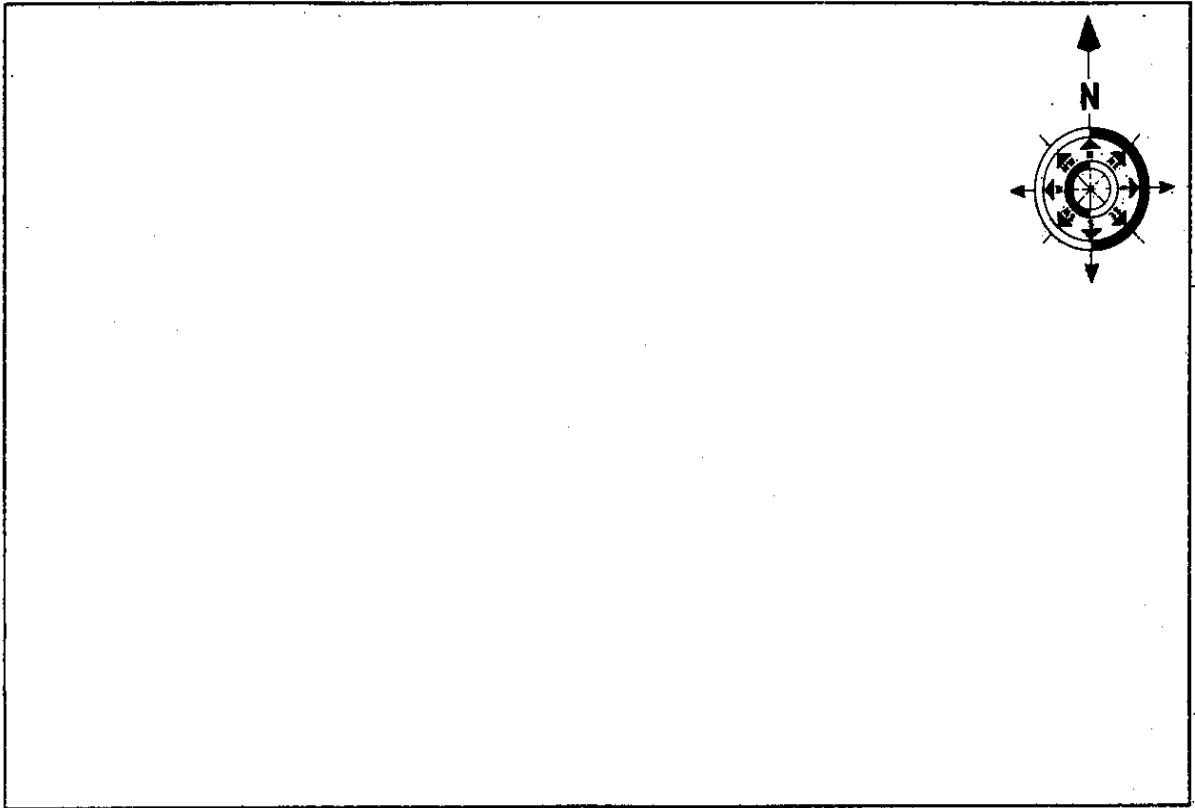
